

MIODRAG KRSTIĆ

Miodrag Krstić is a Full Professor of Internal Medicine at the University of Belgrade and a recognized expert in gastroenterology and hepatology with over 30 years of clinical experience. He specializes in endoscopic and ultrasonographic diagnosis of gastrointestinal diseases, endoscopic ultrasonography, Fibroscan, and capsule endoscopy. He earned his MD from the University of Belgrade in 1984, completed postgraduate and fellowship training in internal medicine and digestive diseases, and received his PhD in 1998 with a focus on portal hypertension in liver cirrhosis. Over his career, he has held numerous academic and clinical leadership positions, including head of the Clinic for Gastroenterology and Hepatology and chairman of the Department of Internal Medicine at the University of Belgrade School of Medicine. Professor Krstić has extensive experience in clinical trials, serving as principal or co investigator in multiple studies on Crohn's disease, ulcerative colitis, chronic hepatitis B, and non-alcoholic steatohepatitis. He is an active member of national and international professional organizations, including the Serbian Gastroenterology Association, the American Gastroenterology Association, and the World Gastroenterology Organisation. He has authored over 120 publications, contributed to 18 books and textbook chapters, and presented widely at international conferences, establishing himself as a leading authority in gastroenterology and hepatology.
