

RADU VLĂDĂREANU

Radu Vladareanu is a Professor and Chair of the Obstetrics and Gynecology Department at Carol Davila University of Medicine and Pharmacy and leads the Obstetrics and Gynecology Department at Elias University Emergency Hospital in Bucharest, Romania. Born in Câmpulung on 1 December 1962, he graduated from Carol Davila University in 1987 as chief of his class and became Professor in 2007. He holds a PhD in Obstetrics and Gynecology and has held numerous leadership roles in Romanian and international professional societies, including President of the Romanian Society of Obstetrics and Gynecology, President of the Romanian Society of Ultrasound in Obstetrics and Gynecology, and Vice-President of the South-East European Society for Endometriosis and Infertility. He is also a European Board and College of Obstetrics and Gynecology Council Member representing Romania and a Regular Fellow of the International Academy of Perinatal Medicine. Professor Vladareanu directs the Ian Donald Inter-University School of Ultrasonography in Obstetrics and Gynecology and has served as Editor-in-Chief or Co-Editor of several major journals. He has authored 8 books, 31 textbook chapters, 5 translations of international textbooks, 75 ISI-indexed papers, and over 200 additional peer-reviewed publications. He has organized and presided over numerous national and international congresses and has been an invited speaker at more than 80 international events, with an H-index of 12 (Web of Science, Clarivate).
